All comments should relate to the original Facebook post. The use of profanity, discriminatory or harassing language, comments/discussions on active investigations/cases and links to third party sites is prohibited. Comments containing this content will be removed. Persistent violation could result in being blocked from this page. Prosecutors legally and ethically can't discuss details of pending cases on Facebook. Please do not post requests for assistance or notifications about emergencies on this page. This page is not monitored for urgent requests.

Contact your local police department for law enforcement matters, and for emergencies dial 911.

Social Media Public Policy – Example

- Once posted, the County reserves the right to delete submissions that:
- contain vulgar language, personal attacks of any kind, or offensive comments that target or disparage any ethnic, racial, or religious group.
- (i) spam or include links to other sites; (ii) clearly off topic; (iii) advocate illegal activity; (iv) promote particular services, products, or political organizations; or (v) infringe on copyrights or trademarks.
- Any submission, including any deleted comment, may be deemed a “record” for purposes of Chapter 149 of the Ohio Revised Code.
